Oak Academy Sports Day – 24th July 2018

We are pleased to announce that Sports Day this year will be taking place off site at Kings Park Athletics Track, Bournemouth on Tuesday 24th July 2018. As a department we feel that a change in format and venue will provide students with a better experience of this whole school event. It will allow students to achieve their maximum potential in a variety of sporting activities, including the traditional athletic track and field events, where we expect plenty of existing school records to be broken!

Students will leave Oak Academy by bus at 9:00am and will return for approximately 4:00pm. Therefore, students will need to come into school at the normal time of 8:30 to ensure a quick and smooth transition down to Kings Park is achieved. Any student who is late to school that day will be expected to make their own way down to Kings Park.

As students will be off site all day, plenty of water and a packed lunch will be required. For those students that are entitled to free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided. Given the recent heatwave, sun-cream and a hat are essential items for every student, and we will ensure that students will have access to the stands for shade and be kept out of the sun when not competing. Students will be expected to wear their normal PE Kit, with the exception that they may substitute their black PE top with a coloured T-Shirt of their assigned house colour. Please can we insist that no football shirts are worn.

Throughout the day we will also have use of the café, which will be open to all. The café serves various refreshments as well as some hot food which students may purchase at break and lunch. Costs of items in the café are similar to those of a normal high street café.

This event is another positive milestone as Oak continues to improve and we would like to invite as many parents/carers as possible to come and enjoy the day with us. Please be aware though, that only parent/carers that have returned this slip back by the 19th July will be allowed into the athletics stadium on the day.
