**RE: Onsite Provision for Students – Dress Code**

During this latest period of lockdown we have remained open to vulnerable children and children of critical workers and have been encouraged by the significant increase in families requesting this provision, in comparison with the first period of lockdown in March.

We have the space and capacity to manage this increase safely, following our risk management plan, and I am thankful to the students attending and their parents for their support and adherence to this plan.

As with our remote learning expectations, there is a need to establish positive working routines, normal to the typical expectations and rules we already have in place.

I am writing therefore to explain a change in our expectation for students attending onsite provision.

From Monday 25<sup>th</sup> January, students attending will be expected to wear full academy uniform.

This should include the academy bag if bringing books, lunchboxes or other additional equipment. Students will be permitted to wear their academy PE kit on days where they have Core PE.
