Dear Parents/Carers

RE: Onsite provision during school closure

Many thanks for letting us know that you wish your child to be onsite during this period of school closure. Onsite access will begin from Tuesday 5th January for all the sessions you have indicated. A further survey will follow later this week to allow you to confirm the times you would like us to support next week.

Onsite provision has been split into two sessions, morning and afternoon, to support registration and safeguarding of students on site. Students are welcome to stay all day if you have indicated this in your survey.

Arrival to school

Students should arrive to school at either 8.30 or 12.30 ensuring they keep a social distance from other students. On arrival students should report to the school canteen where they will be registered and taken to their base for the day.

Uniform

Students **do not** need to wear their academy uniform during their time onsite. Students may wear their own clothes although we would ask that these are conducive for learning.

Break and Lunchtime

Students will of course be given breaks in the day. Our school canteen remains closed so we would ask that students arrive at school with food and drink for the day. Those students who receive FSM will receive vouchers in the next couple of days.

Face Masks


Face masks will need to be worn while moving around the school site. Please ensure your child brings one with them. If they are exempt students will need to wear an Exemption Lanyard. We do now have a stock of these in school which can be purchased on parent pay. Please do this ahead of them arriving if you wish to purchase one.

Lessons

During their time onsite students will follow the same remote learning that the rest of the Academy will follow. They will not get face to face contact with their teachers during this time.
