
RE: Home testing for students

Students have now been given their three opportunities for onsite lateral flow tests at the Academy and are therefore ready to move to home testing. Today your child has received two packs of three home test kits to use over the next few weeks.

Staff and students who have given consent will test twice weekly from now on. This should be done on a **Sunday and Wednesday evening**. You will receive more tests before the Easter break to ensure students can test before they return.

Along with test kits your child has been provided with an instruction video illustrating how to carry out the test. As they are under 18 the guidance suggests that your child should test with adult supervision. Following each test, you will need to log results with both NHS Track and Trace and the academy.


