Euro 2020 Reading Challenge

As part of Oak Academy celebrating and embracing the Men's European Football Championships this Summer, the PE department would like to introduce a reading challenge. For the duration of the tournament which ends on 11th July 2021, the PE department are encouraging students to read as much as possible. The reading challenge will involve students recording how much they have read each day, with the number of pages read contributing to the size of the final prize.

The overall prize for the student that contributes the most will be a Euro 2020 panini sticker album with a number of packs of stickers, with a number of smaller prizes on offer also. The number of packs will be determined by the number of pages that students at Oak Academy read. For every 20 pages read, Oak PE Staff will add 1 pack of 5 stickers. The more students read, the more stickers they could potentially win!

Students who wish to take part can use the library at break and lunch, any dedicated reading time in lessons, as well as any home reading they do which ties into our whole school approach of reading which is a minimum of 20 minutes per day at KS3 and 30 minutes per day at Key Stage 4. Students that take part will need to enter the number of pages they read on Microsoft Teams, with a weekly update on progress overall released every Monday.

The English department have very kindly offered to allow students to loan books from the school library. This can be done during break and lunch times; however, parents and carers must have ParentPay set up and the slip below signed and returned to school. Without the above the loaning of books will not be permitted.

We look forward to seeing the number of pages read increase over the coming weeks.
