Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Reminder: Start of Term Arrangements

I hope you've managed to have an enjoyable summer break with family and friends, with students now ready and energised to return to Oak when term starts in a few days.

This letter is to give a reminder of our key expectations and the start of term arrangements for each year group.

Operational Plan and Risk Assessment

Guidance has changed, making for a return to the "normal" education experience prior to the pandemic. Some restrictions and control measures do remain, in order to reduce the risk of infection transmission and we continue to have a detailed operational plan and risk assessment in place. Uniform

We will be monitoring uniform very closely to ensure our dress code is being followed, taking action where this is not the case – thank you in advance for your support in this matter.

Mobile Phones

With raised expectations and a clear consequence when they are misused, students have quickly learnt to keep mobiles out of sight (and mind), particularly during lesson changeover. This has made such a positive difference to the running of the academy day – it's stopped arguments, placed a focus on learning, and generally helped some students reconnect with others in the real, physical world. These are all good things, and our policy will continue when we return in September.

Student Expectations

We have high expectations at Oak, and, despite the pandemic, will continue to work hard in upholding these expectations so that the quality of education and standards we believe in are maintained. Positive behaviour, a smart appearance and pride in the academy is now the norm across all year groups, with only a small number of students now requiring our support to make better choices.

Everyone has the right to learn without disruption and I make no apologies for taking a firm line on this – we've worked hard to raise standards, and these will remain when we come back in September.

Ofsted have rightly identified the benefits of a firm but fair approach, parental feedback indicates the same.

It's therefore important that all students return to Oak in September with correct uniform, appropriate equipment, including a water bottle, and the positive attitude required to be successful in the real world.

I know for many this will already be the case. Where it is not yet in place, do know that students will be supported through our policies to make necessary improvements to be the 'best they can be.'

Canteen Access

Our canteen will be open to all students at break and lunch – current guidelines have removed the need to maintain bubbles. We remain a cashless academy, so existing students will need to ensure accounts are credited before purchases can be made. **For our new Year 7**, you are advised to bring packed lunches for the first few days as we complete the registration process with you. If you are without food and need to purchase from the canteen, we will make a note of the amount spent and charge this to your account once it is set up.

Start of Term Arrangements

All students (where consent is given) will be given two LFD tests onsite, 3 days apart. Following these onsite tests, home testing kits will again be issued on a regular a basis.

All year groups will initially arrive on site for LFD test one only.

Year 7 and Year 11 will do this on Friday 3rd September. Years 8, 9 and 10 will do this on Monday 6th September.

Term begins fully for Years 7 and 11 on Monday 6th September. Term begins fully for Years 8, 9 and 10 on Tuesday 7th September.
