Tips to Achieve Positive Attendance

- In these more challenging times, positive attendance is still very important.
- Medical appointments need to be out of school hours where possible.
 Appointment letters or card for any in school hours need to be provided prior to the appointment.
- Do not take days off for minor illnesses, birthdays or other family matters.
- Term time holidays will NOT be authorised. A fine will be processed.



Reporting Absence

 If no contact is made with the school or no reason given for the absence, this will be recorded as an unauthorised absence. These absences could lead to a Penalty Notice and fine.

COVID guidelines

- Students need to be in school if they are not showing symptoms of Covid.
- Students should take a Lateral Flow test every Wednesday and Sunday evening.
- If a family member tests positive students are still expected to be in school providing they have a daily negative Lateral Flow test and are displaying no symptoms.
