

Home Learning KS3

Dear Parents/Carers

At Oak Academy, we believe fully in the value of Home Learning. On behalf of your child's teachers I would like to thank you for all your support with this so far, this academic year.

As a reminder our expectations is that all students in Key Stage 3 (Years 7-9) will be expected to complete a minimum of 1 hour home learning per weekday. This will be broken down into the following chunks:

- 20 minutes reading for pleasure – to be recorded in reading logs, signed by parents, and checked by tutors
- 20 minutes Hegarty Maths – to be managed by Maths dept.
- 20 minutes Knowledge Organiser revision/Quizzes – students will complete sections of their knowledge organisers at home, using the 'Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check' (LSCWC) method, alongside completing short quizzes.


New Knowledge Organisers have been given out for T3 and students have begun to learn the knowledge and key vocabulary needed for their learning in all their subjects this term. To further support our students, we have put together a Home Learning Grid for all year groups. This works alongside the Home Learning Timetable and details the exact element of the Knowledge Organiser that your child is expected to learn each day.

Help and support for all students is also available every Wednesday in IT4. This session will be supervised by at least one teacher and runs between 3pm and 4pm. Students can take and complete their Knowledge Organiser work as well as use the computers to complete Hegarty Maths tasks or just do some reading.
