Fossil Fuels

Formation of fossil fuels

Crude oil, coal and gas are fossil fuels. They were formed over millions of years, from the remains of dead organisms:

- coal was formed from dead trees and other plant material
- crude oil and gas were formed from dead marine organisms



Coal is a solid fossil fuel

Fossil fuels are non-renewable. This we are using them up faster than they can be replaced - once they have all been used up, they cannot be replaced. Fossil fuels are also finite resources. They are no longer being made or are being made extremely slowly. It is predicted that we will run out of fossil fuels within the next 40-50 years.

Fossil fuels are used because they are reliable, convenient to use as thermal power stations are set up to burn them and are a relatively cheap energy resource.

When we burn fossil fuels gases are released which have a negative effect on the environment. Sulphur dioxide is released which forms acid rain. Carbon dioxide is released, and this is a greenhouse gas.

The greenhouse effect

Greenhouse gases trap heat and this increases Earth's surface temperature. Greenhouse gases present in the atmosphere include:

- water vapour
- carbon dioxide
- methane


These greenhouse gases:

- 1. Absorb heat from the sun and heat radiated from Earth
- 2. then release energy in all directions, which keeps the Earth warm
