Site Name/Location: Chalke Valley History Festival, Manor Farm, Church Bottom, Broad Chalke, SP5 5DP

Dress code: Pupils can wear their own clothes, (no spaghetti straps, shoulder less tops or cropped tops ect). The festival is a large field on a farm, so comfortable footwear is advised. It is forecast to be a warm day, so please ensure your child is dressed for this. We would also recommend they apply sunscreen.

Lunch: Pupils to bring a packed lunch and plenty of water for the day. Pupils eligible for free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch from the school canteen before departure.

Money: There is no need to bring cash, all the events are covered in the ticket price. However, there will be stands with items for sale if your child wishes to bring a small amount of cash.
