Re: National Education Union – Industrial Action

As many of you will be aware, teachers in the National Education Union voted to take industrial action and there are further strikes on the following dates later this term: **5 July 2023 and 7 July 2023**. This action will affect our school and we will not be able to open for every year group on these dates.

We have made a decision, based on the information we have, that the school will be open to the following year groups:

Wednesday 5 July 2023 – Years 7, 8 and 10 only will attend school. Year 9 will work remotely unless vulnerable or where adults in the house are critical workers.

Friday 7 July 2023 – Years 9 and 10 only will attend school. Year 7 and 8 will work remotely unless vulnerable or where adults in the house are critical workers.


